## care force DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Do you think most people are more excited about going to Heaven or watching today's Super Bowl? Please explain the reasoning behind your answer.
2. Specifically, what & how does Satan spread lies about the following:
  - God's Character and Reliability
  - God's People/The Church
  - God's Home (Heaven)
3. How would it change the Del City Church of Christ if every member was genuinely excited about going to Heaven? What impact might it have on our community?
4. Let's do some word association. When you hear the word "*worship*" what immediately comes to mind?
5. It's been said that, "*God doesn't need our worship, but we need to worship God.*" Do you think this statement is accurate? Why or why not? If you believe it's true please explain your reasoning.
6. Ask a group member to read Romans 12:1-2. Do you think we tend to limit what "worship" actually means? In other words, do we often assume that worship is just something we do on specific days in specific places? How would Paul's admonition in this passage change the way we view worship? How would this change impact the way we live?
7. Do you consider yourself to be a "natural" worshipper? In other words, does worship come relatively easy to you or is it a struggle to keep your focus? What tends to distract you most from worship?
8. Honesty check: During times of corporate worship what do you think about most? What others are doing? What others might be thinking about you? What you're going to have for lunch? What God has done for you?
9. Ask a group member to read Revelation 7:9-12. What adjectives would you use to describe the worship of God in this passage? How is this glimpse of worship in Heaven similar to our corporate worship? How is it different?
10. Do you think our worship now should more closely reflect worship in Heaven? Please explain your answer.
11. Worship should obviously be directed at God, but how should worship change us?
12. What do you personally need to do to bring your worship of God more in-line with what Scripture says?
